1st Place in each meat category will receive \$225.00 and a trophy

3rd Place in each meat category will receive a trophy

Open Dessert: An additional fee of \$20.00 to enter a dessert. 1st Place wins 50% of entry and a trophy

Bloody Mary's: An additional fee of \$10.00 to enter -1st Place wins 70% of entry and a trophy

Dessert and Bloody Mary's must be made onsite

Rules and Regulations

1. Move in date and times: Any and all teams may move in as early as possible on May 1st. Champions personnel will be on location for setup (Thursday move in available upon request)
2. Space Requirements: A 30 x 30 space will be provided for all teams. Larger space, if available will require additional fees.
3. Meat: Pork Spare Ribs. 9 individual ribs with (bone in). Chicken- 2 Fully jointed half chickens with (wing, wing tip, breast, thigh and leg). Brisket 9 slices. Head cook's meeting: Cook's meeting will be conducted by IBCA. You will be picking up your turn-in containers at the meeting. This meeting will be at 7:30 PM (sharp) Friday evening. **THIS MEETING IS MANDATORY.**
4. Alcohol and soft drinks: The cooking area will be sectioned or taped off. Each team may bring in
5. their own alcoholic beverages or soft drinks but you may not come out of the taped off area with your own drinks or alcohol. Outside the taped off area, you will be required to purchase all drinks from Papa's. This will be strictly enforced and IT'S THE LAW. No under-age drinking will be

tolerated. Please limit glass bottles or containers. Use cans or plastic when possible. If you must bring your dogs, you will be responsible to pick up after them. All dogs must be on a leash.

6. **Electricity and Water:** Electricity and Water will not be provided. Please bring your own generators.
7. **Sanctioned Cook-Off:** This will be a sanctioned cook-off. The IBCA will do all judging. All cookers will agree to any and ALL the rules that the IBCA committee may require.
8. **Clean-Up:** All teams will be required to police their own area and pick up any and all trash.
9. **Move-out time:** All teams and equipment MUST be moved out by noon on Sunday.

11. **Directions to Papa's Ice House:** Papa's Ice House is just south of The Woodlands, TX. From Beltway 8 (north) and I-45, take I-45 north about 13 miles to Rayford Sawdust exit. Exit Rayford Sawdust and make a U-turn, go south on feeder to Pruitt Road., turn right. Papa's Ice House is about 1,000 yards on the right. Campsites are in the rear of the building's parking lot.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. Please remember this is a family affair even though alcohol will be consumed at this function. You are responsible for any of your guests that may be underage.
2. All music to be kept at a reasonable level (be respectful of your neighbors) this is not a battle of the amps.
3. Once the cook-off area is set up there will be NO driving in or out of cooking area for everyone's safety. The only vehicles allowed will be golf carts that will be driven by CKC personnel.
4. Quiet time is at 12:00 midnight and will be strictly enforced. If you do not adhere, you will be asked to leave and all entry fees will be forfeited.
